FUTURE GOALS



01. Education for Underprivileged Children

To provide top class education facilities to the children in rural Bengaluru. This program will give impetus to work with the youngsters who are facing financial difficulty in attending the school during the middle years or to the chronic dropouts.

The Beneficiaries include 20 backward villages in the city, and:

- Child laborers (children aged between 2-14 years)
- Rescued children from Karnataka police child helpline
- Children from slums
- Orphan children of the destitute mothers
- Girl children from difficult circumstances
- HIV/AIDS infected children
- Children of the sex workers
- Dropouts from target villages
- Semi orphans/single parents' girl children



02. Unnathi Skill Lab Project

The project aims to empower Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) in Karnataka by providing market-relevant employability and entrepreneurship training. The project's scope includes establishing a Skill Lab, equipping participants with essential employability skills, facilitating job placements, and raising awareness about the capabilities of PWDs.

- Addresses barriers faced by PWDs in accessing education, training, and employment
- Promotes economic empowerment and independence.
- Contributes to social inclusion and reduces stigma.
- Aligns with WHO CBR objectives and UN SDGs.
- Builds a talent pipeline and promotes diversity in the workforce, and entrepreneurship

03. Skill Training for the Youth & Women

Our skill training program is aimed at youth & women empowerment. It is a vocational training and transformation program which will help marginalized youth to secure steady and stable employment, thus elevating their financial situation.
